About this document

HP Systems Insight Manager (HP SIM) uses CIM/WBEM servers and providers that conform to the Storage Management Initiative Specification (SMI-S). Before HP SIM can manage and report on a storage device, the appropriate SMI-S provider must be installed and configured.

Models supported

- HP StorageWorks Modular Smart Array 1500cs
- HP StorageWorks Modular Smart Array 1000

Requirements

- For support with HP Systems Insight Manager, HP SIM 5.0 or later must be installed on the central management server (CMS).
- HP recommends using version 1.0.3.0 or later of the MSA provider with HP SIM. Support for x64 systems was added with version 1.1.0.0 of the MSA provider.
- A host running Windows1 2000 or Windows Server 2003 must have Fibre Channel connectivity to the MSA(s) you want to monitor.

Installing the SMI-S provider

- If a previous version of the SMI-S provider is installed, uninstall it.
- At the host that is connected to the MSA, open a web browser and click one of the following:

- 3. Select your operating system from the list.
- Download the SMI-S provider software from the *Download drivers and software* page.
- 5. Double-click the installation file to install the MSA provider.

NOTE:

The Service Location Protocol (SLP), which optimizes discovery in HP Systems Insight Manager, is automatically installed and started when the SMI-S provider is installed.

Limitations

- HP Systems Insight Manager may experience a slight delay in discovering the MSA arrays while the SMI-S provider gathers information from the arrays for the first time.
- Installing more than one SMI-S array provider on the same host is not recommended. For example, do not install the MSA and EVA providers on the same host.
